Stacking Quail Hutch Kit

Instructions are for a single tiered kit, if numerous tiers are ordered, repeat the assembly process for each section. Only 1 roof is sent per order and will go onto the top tier. Each tier consists of a Back, Front, 2 wooden sides, and either A: $4 \times D$ (standard kit) or B: $2 \times D$ and $2 \times C$



(egg rollout upgrade). The kit will also include 4x "E" (legs), 2x "G" (leg supports), 2x "H" (tray supports). Stacking brackets "I" will be sent in accordance with number of tiers orders. "F" (egg rollout lip) will be sent with upgraded tiers.

1: Lay the back down, white side up and glue in the top two "D" and either bottom 2 "D" or "C" (if upgraded tier). Slide a wooden side into the each side slot, applying glue to the edge before hand.



2. Place the door on top of the 4 corners, ensuring the wooden slide goes into the grove. Be sure to glue the dowels in for stability. If you did not order upgraded tiers, skip to step 4.



3. For upgraded tiers, glue "F" ontp the remaining hole on the "C".




4. For upgraded tiers, slide the black floor wire in from the back, ensuring the top rib goea from back to front of the cage. The floor wire should sit on the lip of "F" by about ½ inch, enough to staple in. The sides of the wire will rest on the guides along "C" and slide underneath the back where it will be stapled. For standard kits, flip the cage upside down and staple the black wire all the way around the edges, pulling it

tight to prevent sagging.

5. Staple the hardware cloth onto the top of the cage, ensuring it is tight.



6. Flip the cage to its side and screw in the front and

back legs "E". Making sure the predrilled hole is facing away from the cage. Flip the cage over and repeat for the other side.





7. Attach both "G". Front "G" goes into the front holes on "E", the other goes on the back, also into the holes on "E".



8. Screw both "H" in between the "G", aligning with the predrilled holes.



9. Place the lid on top. If numerous tiers are ordered, skip to step 10 for stacking bracket placement. Then repeat steps 1-5 for additional tiers.



10. Screw stacking brackets "I" on top of each tier as needed.
